



# A QUICK HISTORY OF SCHROEDER-MANATEE RANCH














- 1905 John Schroeder assembled properties known as Schroeder-Manatee Ranch for lumber and resin.
- 1922 Uihlein Family, original owners of Schlitz Brewing Company, purchase property for \$2/acre.
- 1920s-1960s, land used for small-scale agriculture and hunting.
- 1970s 1980s SMR Board steps up citrus, cattle, shell mining, trees, and turf operations.
- Pressures emerge with advent of I-75
- 1980s SMR Board plans a new course.


### HOW THE BROADER COMMUNITY VIEWED US

- Planners underestimated the impact and value of I-75
- Despite flood zones, want I-75 to serve as the Urban Growth Boundary
- SMR was viewed as too far out for even long-range planning.



- SMR develops its own vision















# LAKEWOOD RANCH: VISION AND POSITIONING






CURRENT USAGE OF COMMERCIAL SPACE






LAKEWOOD RANCH #1 ALL AGES COMMUNITY IN U.S. 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, & 2023


